


A discussion was held on the **FY2019 Cost of Living Adjustment for retirees**. Upon Mr. Wilhelm's motion and Mr. Montleon's second, the Board voted 3-1-1 (Ms. McGinnis' voted nay, Mr. Brock abstained) to approve the FY2019 COLA at 3% on the first \$13,000 under Chapter 32 Section 103(i) to be effective July 1, 2018.

Ms. Baronas gave an **Administrator's Report.** Ms. Baronas reported there is a change forthcoming on the IT Services that Whalley Computer Associates provides to the Hampshire County Retirement System. They have submitted a proposal of the new Managed Services that is being offered. Akuity Technologies is another firm that also provides IT Managed Services and will be conducting a review and submitting a proposal. Ms. Baronas reported

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the website redesign has been completed and the new website is up and running. Lastly, she informed that Board that we have received an estimate to switch the current lighting in the office from fluorescent to LED. There is money budgeted for the switch over under the budget line item Capital Improvements.

The Board reviewed the **RFPs for Actuarial Services**. Upon Mr. Montleon's motion and Ms. Karpinski's second, the Board voted unanimously to select KMS Actuaries LLC to provide actuarial consulting services and to authorize the Chairman to enter into a contract.

Upon Mr. Wilhelm's motion and Ms. Karpinski's second, the Board voted unanimously to authorize travel and reimbursement of expenses for the Board Members and Staff Members as determined by the Chairman to attend the **NEPC 23rd Annual Investment Conference**, May 14 – 15, 2018, in Boston, MA and the **MACRS Annual Spring Conference**, June 3 – 6, 2018 in Hyannis, MA.
